PREPARING STUDENTS FOR THE FUTURE

Many of our students go on to further study at university. We spend a lot of time working with our students on choosing a suitable course and giving themselves the best opportunity in producing a successful application. We guide students through the process of writing a personal statement and making their application through UCAS. We have access to careers advisors for those who are unsure as to what their next step is. Tailor made support is given for all applications. We recognise that the process can be confusing and offer UCAS drop-in sessions for all students.

In addition to supporting our students, we also run information evenings for parents who may be unfamiliar with the process or the changes that have been made over recent years.

For some students, university may not be their first choice and we fully support this. We offer support for students looking for further study at College and assist those looking for an apprenticeship or full-time employment. We work with our students on producing CVs, letters of application and offer mock interviews to give them the best chance of success.
